a Kent Association of Local Councils Medway Area Committee

b Rural Liaison Committee

Cllr Hicks said he had chaired Medway Council's Rural Liaison Committee again and meetings had been held both at Medway Council's offices and in the parishes.

c Lower Upnor Riverside Project

Cllr Hicks said that the costings were being updated and that he was in touch with the new manager of the Arethusa Venture Centre. The Lower Upnor MoD depot site was being developed by the Chatham Rope Company and it was likely that some of the S106 development money would be available for the project. Medway Council was seeking estimates for the repair of the sea wall.

d Upnor Residents' Association

Cllr Hicks said he had attended the AGM of the Upnor Residents' Association and he had been able to provide some information for the Chairman.

e Liberty Park Residents' Association

Cllr Martin said there were some new and enthusiastic committee members. They had had a success in persuading Royal Mail to agree to install a post box somewhere on the development.

f Neighbourhood Watch

Cllr Miller said that Cllr Williams was interested in taking over as Neighbourhood Watch representative. The Chairman proposed a vote of thanks to Cllr Miller for all his efforts on Neighbourhood Watch over the years.
